Healers Do

- Do remember to prepare yourself to serve Infinite Intelligence (God), Spirit healers, and others
- Do remember to attune to the healing Spirit energies
- Do remember to put the sitter at ease
- Do remember to ask sitters permission to touch their shoulders or top of head
- Do remember to follow your local and state ordinances
- Do remember to open with a silent prayer for the sitter's highest and best good
- Do remember to trust the Infinite and request Spirit to send what is needed
- Do remember you are a representative of Spiritualism and act with honor
- Do remember to give a healing with love and compassion
- Do remember to thank Spirit for the positive healing energy

Healers Don't

- Don't diagnose, prescribe, or suggest
- Don't manipulate or massage
- Don't promise to cure all ailments or ills
- Don't give messages while giving the healing as this breaks the sitter's attunement
- Don't talk or pray out loud during the healing as this disturbs others
- Don't wave your hands and arms about flamboyantly—this distracts
- Don't give healing when sick with a cold or flu, etc.
- Don't forget that all healing comes from God and you are the instrument
- Don't ask questions about the condition; let your Spirit healers guide you
- Don't forget to live your religion so that you are an example of health and peace
- Don't forget you are not infallible and only God knows what is for a soul's highest and best good

Spiritualist Healer

A Spiritualist Healer is one who, either through one's own inherent powers or through Mediumship, is able to impart vital, curative force to pathologic conditions.

NSAC Declaration of Principles

(concerning healing)
